**MACKENZIE-DOW UNVEILS CUSTOM ADDITIONS  
TO ENGLISH PUB COLLECTION**

*Family-Inspired Designs Take Center Stage*

Huntington, WV – MacKenzie-Dow is slated to unveil a variety of fresh, family-friendly designs to complement their popular English Pub collection during this month’s International Home Furnishings Show in High Point, NC. Crafted of solid Appalachian Black Cherry, these latest additions focus on the needs and lifestyles of today’s customers. “People are dining and entertaining at home now more than ever,” offers Gary Adams, MacKenzie-Dow president. “To address the ever-evolving requirements of our customers, we’ll introduce a variety of tables that have been designed to accommodate, even inspire, large family gatherings,” he states. “And despite the fact that our furniture is reminiscent of fine antiques, we have not forgotten that today’s families must be able to *live with* their furniture,” he concludes.

Initially unveiled in 2002, the English Pub Collection features an assortment of 18<sup>th</sup>-century reproductions for every room in the home. Both casual and sophisticated, these one-of-a-kind designs have been inspired by the rural cabinetmakers of Old England, who employed centuries-old joinery techniques such as dovetailing, mortise and tenon, and square peg construction. Crafted of solid wild black cherry, the collection is now available in the “Wheatland” finish, a medium brown hue softened with almond-yellow undertones, the “Natural” finish, created without stain and, therefore, reminiscent to “blond” wood, or the new “Malt” finish, a more transitional amber shade that falls between the two. All MacKenzie Dow finishes are enhanced by a hand-wiped, black

glazing process that “catches” in the wood’s inherent distressing, creating an aged effect, akin to well-worn furniture.

Highlights of the new English Pub introductions include an expansive *Pub Table*, which features an authentic planked top. Standing 40” high with a 48” diameter, this new pub table has been designed to accommodate a growing family in a kitchen setting, or to provide cheerful seating in a game room or bar area. In addition, a versatile *Farm Table* design offers three storage drawers on one side of the table, the middle of which is equipped with a false back. Shielded behind the false back, a hidden drawer outfitted with a silverware liner provides extra security.

Sought after by many MacKenzie-Dow retailers, the company will also unveil a custom *Pedestal Extension Table*. Featuring a 60” round top and a “quad” leg design, an additional 21” leaf allows for both tabletop expansion, as well as the insertion of extra chairs without the hassle and interference of conventional table legs. Finally, a generously-scaled 52” *Square Cocktail Table* with two storage drawers and a shelf has been designed to address consumer demand for larger, more functional occasional tables.

Additional introductions include a distinctive new *Hutch* configuration that offers storage drawers for napkins, spices and other dining accessories, as well as a *Plasma TV Stand* that features two side bookshelves and a connecting bridge.

MacKenzie-Dow is a Limited Liability Corporation formed in West Virginia in early 2002.
